It was the arrival of their

daughter Amelie that made Fiona and Tony Hall realise the dated, cramped kitchen in the home they'd lived in for five years would need to go. The poor layout and limited size really hit home with three of them in the house. 'It was impossible for Amelie to be in the kitchen with me while I was cooking,' explains Fiona. 'There wasn't even space for a table in there.'

The solution was to extend across the back of the house and create an L-shaped kitchen and dining space. Fiona and Tony began visiting high-street kitchen retailers, but couldn't find any designs that appealed to them. In the end, inspiration came from a source closer to home. 'My cousin had used C&C Kitchens and recommended it,' recalls Fiona. 'It had a good range of styles and ticked all the boxes.'

Once the couple had decided on the company, the design process could start. 'My absolute musthave was the breakfast bar,' says Fiona. 'It allows Amelie to eat while I continue cooking, plus it's ideal when we're entertaining as people congregate around it, so I don't feel left out.'

Designer Michael Pearcy, from C&C Kitchens, suggested various design details for the open-plan space, such as curved drawers and different-sized units, but when it came to appliances, Fiona and Tony did some careful research. 'We looked into the type of appliances we wanted, as space had been limited in the old kitchen,' says Fiona. 'I'd always wanted an American-style fridge freezer, so was thrilled when I found out Michael had been able to fit it in to the room.'

The building work all went smoothly, apart from a small hiccup. 'After the extension was finished, we found the steel work that supported it was in the way,' says Fiona. 'Michael had to tweak the new layout, but we got there in the end!'

Now the kitchen is complete, the couple are delighted with it. The fact that they can eat, cook and entertain as a family has made all the building work and upheaval worthwhile. 'We love the finished kitchen,' says Fiona. 'It's even better than we imagined and bigger than we anticipated – you could even say it's changed our lives.'
